## Definition

Electrologists permanently remove unwanted hair from the face and body of their clients and patients through the process of using electricity to remove hair at the root.

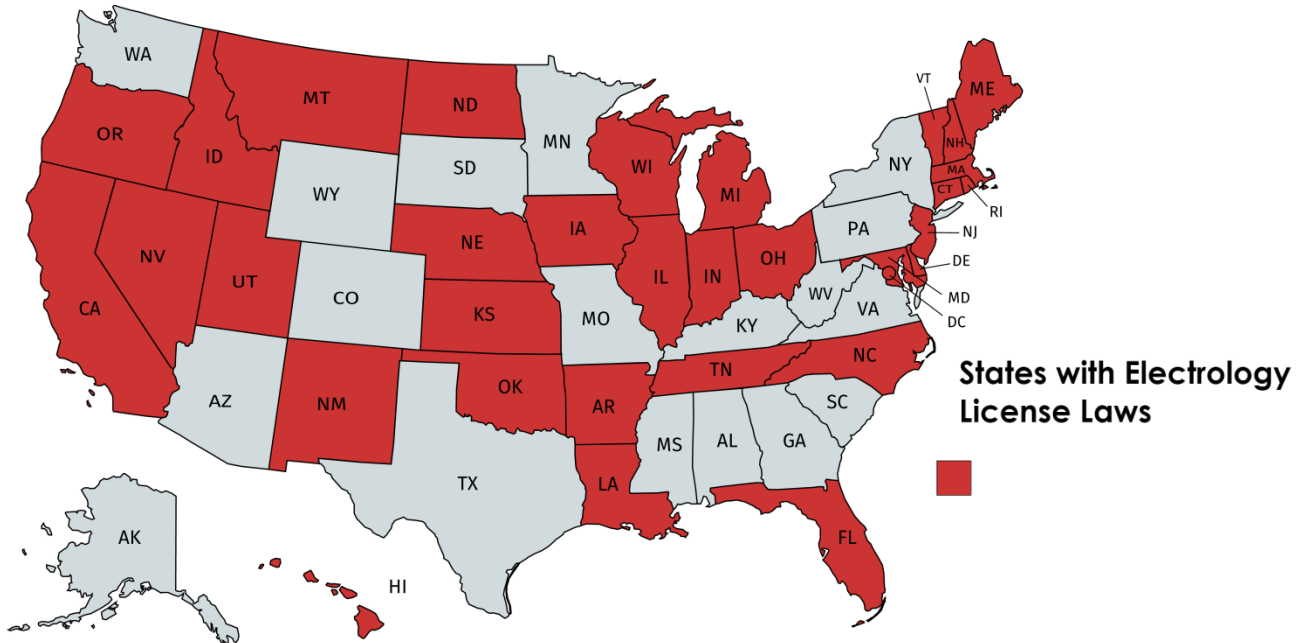
## What LB 343 does

This legislation will reduce the program requirements to be only 600 hours instead of also requiring an additional 600 credits. Repeals the requirement to register with the Department of Health and Human Services. It also eliminates the requirement to register as a guest artist and clarifies guest lecturers are able to visit schools and are not required to receive additional licensure through the Department.

## State Specific Information

To date, 32 states and the District of Columbia have specific licensing requirements for electrologists. Nebraska has the highest fee for electrologists amongst its neighboring states. It also has the most stringent education requirement of all neighboring states.
